

How to Earn the Piedmont Council **Trained Leader Patch/Rockers**

The base patch is “ghosted” showing where placement of the rockers should be when earned. When you have registered and taken Youth Protection and Hazardous Weather, the base patch is free and given when you earn your first training rocker.

To earn the **Position Specific** rocker, you must be fully trained in your registered Primary Position. This training is available on-line and face to face.

The **BALOO/IOLS** rocker is available after you have completed either course. Both courses have an overnight component included and the BALOO course has an online prerequisite.

The **Outdoor Ethics** rocker is available after you have completed either the 60–90-minute BSA Outdoor Ethics Orientation Course, the BSA Leave No Trace 101 Course or the BSA Leave No Trace Trainer 16 hour course.

The **Supplemental** rocker is available after earning any supplemental training in the BSA, such as a UOS, a Shooting Sports Certification, a Commissioner College, etc., but it must be a “Training Course”.

The **Woodbadge** rocker is available after completing the 5 Day or 2 Weekend in person course and the completion of your ticket and application for your Woodbadge Beads.

The **Roundtable** rocker is available after attending at least 6 in person or virtual Roundtables in a year.
