Who : Area, Council, and District Outdoor Ethics Advocates, Leave No Trace Master Educators and Trainers, Tread Lightly! Masters and Trainers, and other interested Scouters who want to join us for this important event.

What : 2016 – National BSA Outdoor Ethics Conference

When : October 6th – 8th, 2016

Where : BSA Camp Tracy – Salt Lake City, UT

Why: New science-based studies will be presented to support what is being promoted as “best practices”. The conference focus will be on delivering the Outdoor Ethics program in your Councils, with information about Outdoor Ethics advancement requirements, Awareness and Action awards, program implementation, working across the multiple levels of our councils (unit, district, council staff and volunteer leadership), with time to share ideas and best practices, and much more.

How Much : Conference Cost: \$140 before 8/22/2016, \$160 after. **Before 8/22 registrants get a shirt and a patch. After 8/22 just a patch.** You will select your shirt size during registration.

Various lodging options are available - rustic shared-men’s and shared women’s cabins w/ bunk beds & pads (\$20 per person for the conference, space limited), 10x12 shared tents w/platform, cots & pads (\$10 per person for the conference), personal-tent-you-bring sites, hammocks too (No Charge), and a few places for trailers, campers or motorhomes (No Charge). There are no hookups.

There are hotels nearby with mid-range prices or you can always stay at one of the numerous ski resorts in the area. Those who live close by may want to sleep at home.

SPECIAL NOTE: Bring your own warm bedding if you are sleeping on-site. Cabins have electricity and are heated by a wood-burning stove. Tents have no electricity or heating.
