



2016 Leave No Trace Master Educator Course

August 8-13 – Hinckley Scout Ranch, Utah

Come enjoy Utah's High Uintas on this 6 day course with both trek and non-trek options that will give participants an in-depth understanding of the ethics and science behind Leave No Trace. The course is designed to give participants the tools needed to effectively make ethical decisions in the outdoors and teach others about Leave No Trace and Outdoor Ethics.



Non-Trek Option

This option will be held at the Hinckley Scout Ranch located on the North slope of Utah's Uinta Mountains. Participants will remain at the camp for the duration of the course and will participate in a number of day excursions to learn about the types of impacts that occur in high use areas and ways to mitigate those impacts. This course has a cap of 7 participants.

Trek Option

This option will also begin at the Hinckley Scout Ranch but will leave for a 4 day backpacking excursion into the spectacular High Uintas Wilderness Area, the largest in Utah. This course will be much more strenuous in nature and will focus on issues that are of concern in more pristine backcountry and alpine areas. This course also has a cap of 7 participants.

Course cost is \$275 and includes all meals and materials. (Steal of a deal!)
