



Leave No Trace Master Educator Course

WHY ATTEND?

Learn in-depth about the seven principles of Leave No Trace through a field-based training experience, with a focus on bringing the message of Leave No Trace to others in Scouting.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Scouters age 18 or older who are interested in learning in-depth about the principles of Leave No Trace and their application, teaching them to others through Awareness courses, and running Leave No Trace Trainer courses in their Districts and Councils.

WHAT DO MASTER EDUCATORS DO?

- Conduct Leave No Trace Trainer courses and Leave No Trace and Outdoor Ethics Awareness workshops
- Lead discussions on Outdoor Ethics with local Troops, Packs, and Crews as they prepare for outings
- Train and mentor youth to serve as Outdoor Ethics Guides in their Troops
- Provide leadership on Outdoor Ethics matters to the District and Council, drawing upon a wealth of knowledge and personal experience

COURSE DETAILS:

First weekend: April 29 to May 1, 2022
Location: Frontcountry at Broad Creek Memorial Scout Reservation

Second weekend: May 12 to 15, 2022
Location: Backcountry (hiking or canoeing) at Broad Creek Memorial Scout Reservation

Attendance at **both** weekends is required

Cost: \$290 per participant
Registration deadline: April 8, 2022
Early Bird rate: \$275 due February 4, 2022

PRE-REQUISITES:

- Completion of the Leave No Trace Trainer course, or equivalent prior experience
- A desire to teach Leave No Trace to others
- Preparation of a presentation on one of the Leave No Trace principles (will be assigned prior to arrival)

All participants will receive an email by April 15 with their teaching assignment, equipment list, and campsite location.
